Vail Valley Art Guild is a 501 (c)(3) non-profit charitable organization.



Spotlight on the Upcoming 10th Annual Vail Valley Fine Art Show

Art can sometimes feel like it's something for "other" people ... people who peruse art galleries for fun, or who spend weekends at the art museum and who know the aesthetic and stylistic context of the art hanging on the walls. The pinky raisers and erudite. But, at CMC, we believe art is for EVERYONE, and that is why we partnered with the Vail Valley Art Guild 10 years ago to create the Vail Valley Fine Arts Show, anchored by the opening reception called "Art and Jazz."

"This is a great way for us to welcome the community into the building, and to make art more accessible to everyone," said Andrew Pranger, former president of the Vail Valley Art Guild and member of the CMC Vail Valley art committee.

More than 200 pieces of art are showcased during the show, which includes photography, ceramics, oils, acrylics, watercolor, mixed media and even video art created by CMC students and artists from the Vail Valley Art Guild.

"The whole event is great," Andrew said. "But, the real power and magic is

when the art is hung on the walls and displayed on the campus, and students and community members walk slowly, enjoying the art in their own time, and they may even learn about some of the great programs and events happening at the college."

"Fine art and Jazz have a long history of working well together," Andrew said. "Jazz is accessible to everyone. And, honestly, the music has gotten better over the years. It's turned into a great night out for more than 500 people."

This year's free Art and Jazz reception will be September 22. It costs \$10 to submit work to the juried art show, and artists must either be CMC students or staff, or a member of the Vail Valley Art Guild.

Important dates for the Annual Colorado Mountain College / Vail Valley Art Guild Art and Jazz Show:

- Tuesday, August 1st: Initial notification to submit forms and photographs. Submissions are limited to five items per artists and photographers. Hanging fees are \$10 per piece. Fees can be paid either online or when items are dropped off.
- Friday, September 1st: This is the last day that photos of work can be submitted for the exhibit catalog.
- Friday, September 15th (12-4) and Saturday, September 16th (9-4): drop off all artwork at CMC. Final submission day is September 16th!
- Monday, September 18th: hang show
- Friday, September 22nd, (5-8): Art and Jazz reception.
- Friday, November 3rd: take down exhibit. If you are interested in showing your CMC works in the community room at the Avon Public Library, individually or teaming up with another member, for details, dates, and logistics please contact Chris Sena if you are interested: cgsena5@gmail.com
