e have recently started the creation of an Eagle County community therapeutic arts program with Renata Marshall who is a trained facilitator in art therapy and spoke at our May members' meeting. She feels that art can work as a means of expression for children and adults going through trauma, depression, or dealing with other emotions related to their life situations. Her initial comment to me was simply "Art saved my life."

While VVAG has always been active in the local community through libraries, schools, our gallery and events, working with students, the elderly, veterans, children and their parents, we have never had the appropriate skills to facilitate "trauma-informed art workshops." We are talking with funders about helping us with this bold and important project which is unique in the county yet fits perfectly with our Mission to enrich lives through visual arts.

To paraphrase our Mission, we enrich lives by:

- Using art as a language to give greater voice to persons striving for expression
- Connecting local visual artists, and those who wish to be, to others in an artistic community
- Creating exhibition and gallery opportunities for local visual artists
- Sponsoring free and low-cost classes and professional workshops in the visual arts to develop and expand skills
- Supporting visual arts education for our youth, elderly and underserved

MAY ARTIST MEETING












OUTSTANDING!
